
Did You Know? ORS Can Help You with Education and Training

What is the Office of Rehabilitation Services (ORS)?

ORS runs the state's Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) program. They help people with disabilities get ready for, find, and keep jobs. ORS can help you:

- Learn about different jobs.
- Get training for a job.
- Find a job that matches your skills and goals.

Can ORS help me get training for my job goal?

Yes. If you need training, a certification, license, or a degree to reach your goals, ORS can help you find the right program.

Can ORS help with the cost of my education and training?

Yes. ORS may help with education and training costs based on your needs. Talk to your VR counselor to learn what help is available.

What can ORS help pay for?

Tuition: ORS can help pay for your training and education. You need to apply for other grants, and your counselor will help with that. ORS **cannot** make you take out student loans.

Books and Supplies: ORS can help pay for books, tools, and materials you need you are your education. This includes special tools and alternative formats.

Transportation: ORS can help with transportation, like learning how to use public transit.

Assistive Technology: ORS can help pay for devices that you need for class, schoolwork, or to participate in education.

Testing and Evaluations: If you need tests to show your disability or help getting the right services, ORS can help. They can also assist with getting licenses or permits for certain jobs or small businesses.
