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## Client Assistance Program (CAP)

Disability Rights Rhode Island's CAP can help you ask for services that help you work and live on your own. We can also help if you already get these services.

### DRRI Can Help with Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)

**VR Services** help you find or keep a job. You may get VR services from the [Office of Rehabilitation Services](#), [Services for the Blind and Visually Impaired](#), or [Tribal Vocational Rehabilitation](#).

DRRI can help if:

- You want VR services, or you were told you cannot get them.
- You have problems with your VR counselor.
- You are not happy with the services you get.
- Your case was closed, and you do not agree.
- You are a student (ages 14 to 21) with questions about transition services.

### DRRI Can Help with Independent Living

**Independent Living Services** help you live on your own. You may get these services from the [Ocean State Center for Independent Living \(OSCIL\)](#).

DRRI can help if:

- You need a change to be able to do your job. This is called a reasonable accommodation.
- OSCIL denied you services.
- You are not happy with the services you get from OSCIL.
- You want to keep living in your own home and need help to do that.

### Other Ways CAP Can Help

- Learn about your rights at work.
- Get information about Assistive Technology (devices that can make life easier).
